HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES

• We sanitize surfaces and disinfect toys daily.

- Student temperatures are taken before they are checked into class.
- If your child has a temperature of 100.6°F or higher, has a runny nose, or is coughing, please keep them home.
- Hands are washed after recess, restroom use, and before lunch.
- Our campus is fully gated with coded access.
- We have Child CPR/First Aid certified staff in every room.
- We use age appropriate toys and a fully child proofed classroom.
- There is a maximum teacher to student ratio of 1:12.
