### COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES

Our priority is the health and wellness of our children and our staff. We are doing everything in our power to ensure a safe, clean environment.

Parents/Guardians that are vaccinated may enter CH mask free. If you're not vaccinated, please continue to wear a mask when entering our campus for dropoff and pick-up.

- We are sanitizing surfaces and disinfecting toys daily.
- Student temperatures are taken before they are checked into class.
